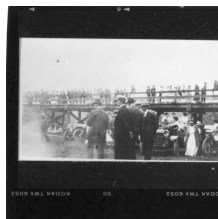

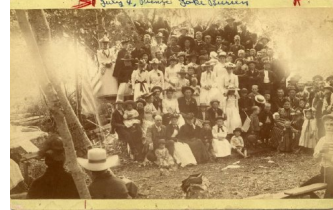

A brief legend says: "It was 1958 and hydro-plane fever was in the air. Burien had its own hydro-plane, the Miss Burien. That parade, dalled Hydro Hilites, was the beginning of the annual parade scene. People lined the streets for hours before the big parade began."
